Subject: Go-live of PPCS (Pension, Passage Benefits and Car Loan System) – Passage benefits and Car Loan Modules

The purpose of this Circular is to inform you that a digital platform has been developed, namely the *Pension, Passage Benefits and Car Loan System* (PPCS), to facilitate the online application, processing and payment/disbursement of Public Service Pensions, Passage Benefits and Car Loan.

2. The PPCS comprises the following three modules:

- Pension Benefits;
- Passage Benefits; and
- Car Loan

The Passage Benefits and Car Loan Modules are scheduled to go live on **10 November 2025** as part of a phased implementation plan.

PPCS will be fully interoperable with existing government platforms including e-HR, e-Payroll, TAS, MAUSIGN and Infohighway, ensuring a paperless, user-friendly, and efficient service.

3. The following Ministries/Departments have been selected as pilot sites for the initial implementation:

- Treasury;
- Ministry of Public Service and Administrative Reforms;
- Ministry of Information, Technology, Communication and Innovation; and
- Ministry of Education and Human Resource.

4. As from **10 November 2025**, officers of these pilot sites will be able to submit their applications for Passage Benefits and Car Loan online.

5. The system and its comprehensive User Manuals, as well as instructional videos (for Applicants), may be accessed at the following URL:

6. The system will be progressively rolled out to other Ministries/Departments over the course of one year, during which targeted training sessions will be provided to HR and Finance users.

7. Until the system is implemented in other Ministries/Departments, existing procedures for receiving and processing applications will remain in effect.

8. Supervising Officers are kindly requested to relay the contents of this Circular to the attention of all officers concerned within your Ministry/Department to ensure a smooth and effective transition to the new system.
